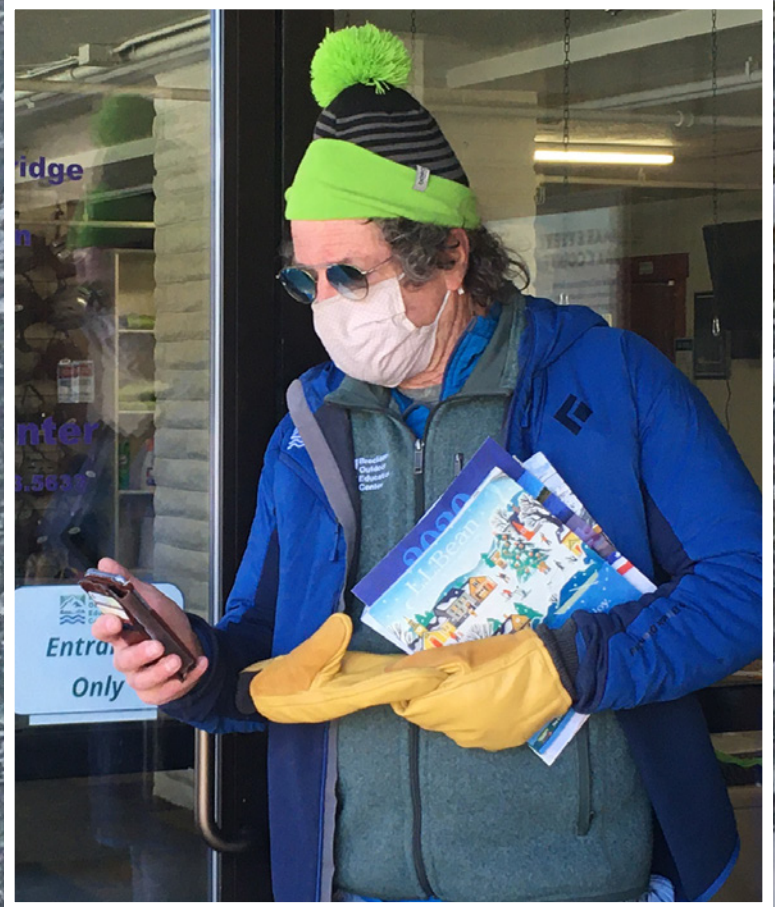


## We are read everywhere
